VICE-PRESIDENT 'S NOTES

As our CMA state rally to Gunnison on July 25-27 approaches, we need to start planning the logistics of our trip.

First, is your registration with the rally completed? And do you have a reservation locked in at a campground or motel?

Second, is your motorcycle ready for this 215 mile, four to five hour ride? The most scenic route is US 285 through Fairplay, Buena Vista and Salida with a right turn on US 50 into Gunnison. Do a maintenance check of your bike for proper tire inflation and tread depth (85% of the problems on the road are related to this omission); fluids check; and battery charge (is the battery holding a good charge after winter storage?) and lights check. If necessary, have your trusted dealer do a checkup of your bike's condition before embarking on a long trip. Carry a small tire repair kit and general maintenance kit for road work.

Third, make sure you are prepared for the road trip. Do you have rain gear, leathers, plenty of water and snack foods for the trip. Take your cell phone with its charger with you. Do you have a small first aid kit? Do you have your maps of the trip planned out with plenty of rest stops for gas and comfort? Our chapter will need to organize whether we are traveling as a group and what those logistics are comprised of.

Last, but not least, do you have plenty of Christ lifting material with you; mainly your small "on the road Bible" and any other witnessing tools you feel are necessary?

Do a spiritual checkup. Start praying for a safe and Christ honoring road trip and rally during your daily devotional time. While wearing your colors carry some of those envelopes about CMA that Roxanne put together to witness to those on the road and in Gunnison. As Christ said: "Be prepared in season and out of season to tell the world about the hope that is within you."

Let's have a fun and safe ride and Christ honoring rally in Gunnison.
